eWaste Disposal, Inc. (EDI) will provide or arrange pickup, transportation, tracking documents and waste reduction/recycling of universal and hazardous waste listed below. Title to all materials passes to EDI upon pickup by EDI. Lamps received at EDI recycling centers will be processed in accordance with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations or other applicable regulatory approvals. Lambs must be packed in cardboard cartons or fiber lamp drums with the ends sealed shut and U.V. labels. Capacitors will be removed and incinerated (PCB) or landfilled (NON-PCB and PCB) as appropriated for ballast classification by an EDI selected EPA permitted facility in accordance with EPA regulations. Lamp ballasts must be packed in DOT UN APPROVED shipping containers. Container tops for all loaded drums shall be secured to the drums. EDI will provide material classification labels to be applied to all ballast containers prior to pickup. All drums of NON-PCB ballast must have the drum lid marked as "NON-PCB" with waterproof marker. EDI will provide proper documentation at time of pickup unless otherwise specified. Batteries <u>must</u> have terminals taped off and separated among different battery types. <u>No mixed containers</u>. Electronic (monitors, TVs, etc...) must be packaged so that damage cannot occur to screens, or minimum damage to any encasement.
